Position Responsibilities:

- The intern will be assigned per event to gain experience and firsthand knowledge providing control room or field staff roles
 including but not limited to the following:
 - Camera Operator Experience should include setting up and effectively operating camera equipment assembling the camera, positioning cameras, assisting with shot selection, camera angles and movements according to requirements by the Director.
 - Audio Experience should include managing and setting up all audio equipment such microphones, cabling and being responsible for all audio packages on events.
 - o A2 Experience should include assisting Audio running microphones, RF, etc. and setting up all audio equipment.
 - Utility Assist with the set-up of equipment, mobile unit and control room for events helping to manage logistical aspects of event in a support role for the technical and production team.
 - Xpression Operator Requires experience operating an Xpression systems for live events managing all aspect related to broadcast graphics.
 - Graphics Producer Responsible for creating graphic elements in a fast-paced live broadcast environment, collaborating
 with producers and other team members to ensure high-quality visuals.
 - o **Technical Director** Must possess the ability to clearly communicate and manage the technical functions for on-site events such as tape, engineering, maintenance, talent and all technical production functions of a live broadcast.
 - o **Replay Operator** Experience with EVS is a plus but other software experience will be considered as training can be provided in our control room.
 - o Production Assistant Experience working with Production Managers to assist with the logistical aspects of live events.
- Will also provide hands on support in field shop when appropriate to garner training and experience with mobile unit production facilities and equipment.
- Will also be provided as time permits with training in other production roles where the intern can glean more experience and harness skills.
